### **Judging & Awards**

Judges at the *International Harlem Science Street Fairs & Festivals Poster & Research Conference* are career researchers that work in academia, industry and government. These judges volunteer their time because of their interest in student research and the future of science and engineering.

Having an abstract accepted for presentation at the *International Harlem Science Street Fairs & Festivals Poster & Research Conference* is an honor. The presentation of student research through a poster and responses to questions by judges will be evaluated against standards common to undergraduate/graduate scientific conferences. Judges will provide feedback based on a number of criteria. A sample Judging Sheet may be viewed for more information.

### **Awards**

There are four levels of recognition given to poster presentations:

**Fair** - An attempt has been made to meet the standards of a scientific presentation, but has not met the requirements expected for a conference at this level. (Certificate of presentation awarded.)

**Good** - the basic level of research and presentation for a conference at this level. (Certificate of presentation awarded.)

**Excellent** - Exceeds the basic level of research and presentation for a conference at this level. (Certificate of presentation awarded.)

**Superior** - Exceeds the basic level of research and presentation to an exemplary degree; one of the best in the conference in the subject area. (Medal, certificate of presentation and monetary prize awarded.)

#### **Presentation Acceptance**

Completed abstracts will receive approval for presentation within three business days after their abstract submission date. An email will be sent to the registrant of the approval or rejection of the abstract. If an abstract is rejected for some reason, monies paid for registration fees will be refunded. *International Harlem Science Street Fairs & Festivals Poster & Research Conference* is not, however, responsible for travel or lodging expenses incurred by the registrants.
